

Procedure of 2022 IAEG Election

- a. The Secretariat has been collecting information from the Council to confirm their attendance online or not. Council members who can not attend the online Council meeting can choose to vote via email in real name. Proxy vote is not accepted this time both on and off line.
- b. National/Regional Groups can only appoint one representative to take part in the online voting part via Zoom system by secret ballot.
- c. Those who are unable to attend the online meeting is required to send the email voting by the deadline September 12th, 2022, to the Secretary General as well as the scrutineer Mark Eggers (Email: Mark.Eggers@psm.com.au) for double checking. Expired email voting are considered invalid.
- d. At the online Council meeting, the Secretary General will announce the list of representatives who will take part in the online voting part and the email votings received before the deadline. The total number of both email and online votes should reach the legal quorum (25%) as Bylaws and then accepted by the Council before the online voting. The online voting results should be immediately shown to the Council and then the Secretary General will add the email voting results into the online voting results, and show the total vote results to the Council.
- e. The candidates are required to send the Secretary General a short video on self-introduction and election statement before August 20th, 2022. The video is 3 minutes for Secretary General, Treasurer, Vice Presidents candidates and 5 minutes for candidates of President respectively. The email voting could start after the distribution of candidates' video and application documents among the Council members.
- f. The candidates are also required to give oral election statements to the Council before the voting part for 3 minutes for candidates of Secretary General, Treasurer, Vice Presidents and 5 minutes for candidates of President respectively. For positions having only one candidate, he/she must secure a simple majority of votes. For positions having more than one candidate, the one(s) who is in first /second place by the votes can be selected as the winner(s) of the position(s). In the event of a tied vote, the President shall cast a tie-breaking vote.
- g. The president will announce the final result of election.
- h. The elected new President is invited to give an address to the Council.
- i. During the voting part, if some of the representatives with vote right are unfortunately fail to vote such as disconnection or other situations, as long as the legal Quorum (25%) is reached, their votes will be considered invalid and the election will continue.

IAEG Statutes Article VI - ADMINISTRATION

3.Voting

Voting may be by show of hand (or through a secret ballot if called for by any two members of the Executive Committee or Council). Decisions of the Executive Committee or of Council will be carried by a simple majority of votes except for decisions on amendments to the Statutes and By Laws and on the affiliation or dissolution of the Association which must be decided by a majority of two thirds of the votes cast.

In the event of a tied vote, the President (or the Chairman of the meeting in the absence of the President) shall cast a tie-breaking vote.

The Quorum of Council for the legal transaction of Association business shall be at least a quarter of the members of Council including at least three members of the Executive Committee.
